Said funds, with accumulated interest to date of withdrawal, are to be transferred to the general fund. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 3: To see if the School District will vote to discontinue the School Bus Reserve Fund (Capital Reserve Fund), created in 1984. Said funds, with accumulated interest to date of withdrawal, are to be transferred to the general fund. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 4: To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.
